Title: Assistant Professor, Early Childhood Education

Candidates will also be responsible for seeking external funding for early childhood initiatives.

Qualifications: Successful candidates will have a doctoral degree (with ABD considered, but degree must be in-hand by December 2010) in early childhood, or a closely related field and will be eligible for graduate faculty membership based on scholarly productivity. In addition to familiarity with standards-based education, candidates must have a minimum of 3 years of successful prek-3 experience or the equivalent.
